# **PROJECT PROGRESS**

Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India is the nodal ministry of Drug Demand Reduction in the country. In this regard, the National Institute of Social Defence, an Autonomous Institute under the Ministry has been conducting various awareness and capacity building programmes on the issue of drug use/abuse in collaboration with various Institutes/agencies in different States.

#### May, 2019

The NISD vide its memo F.No.45/7/2019-NCDAP/NAPDDR dated 22.05.2019 requested the SCERT, West Bengal for proposal for awareness generation and Capacity building Programme on drug demand reduction in schools. The NISD had provided a project proposal template to submit the proposal.

#### July, 2019

SCERT, West Bengal had submitted the proposal to NISD in their template vide Memo no. 386/F.No.686/SCERT dated 22.07.2019. SCERT, West Bengal had submitted the proposal with an involvement of Rs.51,75,000/- and proposed to cover 18060 persons in 131 days.

#### August, 2019

NISD organised a one day Workshop on "Substance Use Prevention for Directors & Nodal Officers of SCERT" on 02<sup>nd</sup> August, 2019 through NCERT.

The NISD sanctioned Rs.17,00,000/- to SCERT, Department of School Education , GoWB for the programme and it was mentioned in the sanction order that the programme has to be completed within 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 . Accordingly, NISD released Rs.13,60,000 being 80% of the total sanctioned amount.

#### September - October, 2019

Meanwhile, SCERT was doing the First Phase of 'School Leadership Development' as approved by the PAB of Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan. It was then felt appropriate to hold the First State Resource Group Meeting on 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 at DIET, Alipurduar and the second SRG was scheduled on 24<sup>th</sup> -25<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 at SCERT, Kolkata. In these two days, the SRG developed the training materials and various formats for the programme. On 30.10.2019, the SRG again met for finalisation of transaction modalities, school level activities and the training plan.

#### November 3, 2019, Sunday

The SRG left Kolkata on 3<sup>rd</sup> November (Sunday) for Alipurduar from Santragachhi Station at 10.25 a.m. and reached the DIET, Alipurduar at 2.00 a.m. of Monday through NJP Station.

For last few days, it was hectic; therefore, the team called it a day around 11.00 p.m.

#### November 11, 2019, Monday

The School based programme was held in the districts of Darjeeling, Kalimpong, & Cooch Behar.

The Principal, DIET, Darjeeling did the monitoring of schools of Darjeeling and the Principal, Kalimpong PTTI and his team monitored the schools of Kalimpong. The F.O., SCERT, Sk. Anisujjaman and HOI & SRG, Altaf Hossain monitored 5 schools of Cooch Behar, the Principal, DIET, Cooch Behar & Shri Pradip Jha, SRG monitored 5 schools of Cooch Behar & Shri Ajit Saha, OC, DIET Alipurduar, Shri Ranjan Roy, HOI & SRG,

Shri Subhadeep Maiti, Staff, DIET North 24 Parganas & SRG and Shri Sujit Haldar, Staff, DIET Murshidabad & SRG visited the 4 schools. The teams collected all the materials from the schools and deposited the same at DIET, Alipurduar. The last monitoring team reached DIET, Alipurduar at around 10.30 p.m.

#### November 12, 2019, Tuesday

This is a rest day for the team but the team at Alipurduar started digitising the school based materials of Cooch Behar and Alipurduar. The State Coordinator held a meeting with the monitoring team of Siliguri which comprised of HOIs and Samsul Alam, HOI & SRG and briefed them about the monitoring format and collected the materials of Darjeeling at Siliguri. Meanwhile, Mr. Alam was requisitioned by the Commissionarate a training programme for the HOIs of Darjeeling & Kalimpong and the responsibility of monitoring thus fall on the State Coordinator.

#### November 13, 2019, Wednesday

The School based programme was held in the districts of Siliguri, Alipurduar & Jalpaiguri. Shri Ajit Saha, OC, DIET, APD & Shri Ranjan Roy, HOI&SRG monitored 7 schools of Alipurduar. Shri Pradip Jha, SRG & Shri Subhadeep Maiti, Staff, DIET North 24 Parganas monitored 5 schools of Alipurduar. Shri Sujit Haldar, Staff, DIET Murshidabad & SRG and Altaf Hossain HOI & SRG, monitored 3 schools of Alipurduar. After monitoring and in the evening Shri Sujit Haldar left Alipurduar for Kolkata. The last monitoring team of Alipurduar assembled and deposited the school based activity at around 9.00 p.m.

There was morning school in the Siliguri and it was a girl's school. The monitoring of Siliguri thus started from 7.00 a.m. The materials from Kalimpong were collected in the same day. The monitoring team and the HOIs gathered at Matigara Harasundar High School and checked all the materials. The State Coordinator left with the materials of Darjeeling, Siliguri & Kalimpong from Matigara at 8.00 p.m.

The OC, DIET, Jalpaiguri, Smt. Sharmistha Majumdar monitored 7 schools of Jalpaiguri and among the schools she visited there was one Ashram Type School at Dhapganj. Shri Kshounish Guha, HOI & SRG monitored 7 schools of Jalpaiguri.

The State Coordinator reached Jalpaiguri around 9.45 p.m. at Jalpaiguri and collected the materials as submitted by the district team of Jalpaiguri and left Jalpaiguri around 11.00 p.m.

The State Coordinator reached the DIET, Alipurduar with school based activity materials of Darjeeling, Kalimpong, Siliguri & Jalpaiguri at around 3.00 a.m. The team called it a day around 4.00 a.m. in the morning.

#### November 14, 2019, Thursday

The team started working from 10.00 a.m. in the morning. The team sought help from WEBEL Technology Ltd and Cooch Behar DIET for scanning of the school based material as received from Siliguri, Jalpaiguri, Darjeeling and Kalimpong. The work was completed around 3.00 a.m. in the morning.

#### November 15, 2019, Friday

The team collected the materials and packed them and left the DIET, Alipurduar around 2.00 p.m. to catch the train to Kolkata. The team carried with them all the guardian worksheet as received and collected. The State Coordinator & Shri Subhadeep Maiti, Staff, DIET North 24 Parganas on their way back to Kolkata discussed about various experiences about their monitoring and it was found these few days have opened up new sets of learning for the team.

#### November 16, 2019, Saturday

The team reached Sealdah Station in the morning and with them carried back huge data which needs to be entered and analysed.

#### January, 22, 2020 Monday - February, 15, 2020, Saturday

This huge data was entered by the Data Entry Operators from DIET, Nadia and Hooghly under the supervision of Shri Subhadeep Maiti, Staff, DIET North 24 Parganas & SRG and Shri Sujit Haldar, Staff, DIET Murshidabad & SRG at SCERT.

The SRG again met on 14.02.2020-15.02.2020 to deliberate on the data and analysing qualitative data of the Monitoring Schedule. The chapters of the report cover page and the interpretation guidelines were discussed. It was discussed and approved unanimously that the Report writing team need to work again for one day on 25.02.2020 to finalise the report.

#### February, 15, 2020, Saturday- February, 24, 2020, Monday

The data mining and analysis was undertaken by the State Team at SCERT in Kolkata.



#### February, 25, 2020, Tuesday – March, 11, 2020, Wednesday

The workshop was started from 11.00 a.m. and around 7.00 p.m. the report of NAPDDR activities were finalised with seven volumes. The volumes are –

The main report details and delineates the overall State Activity. It includes perceptions of the guardians regarding use of substance use and their aspirations about future of their children. The main report also catches the programme implementation through its various nuances from the system level perspective.

The six individual district reports details the actual outreach of the programme and contains data regarding school, teachers and students. The report also contains the various activities done by the students and guardians. The activities were drawing, slogan & poster making and creative writing. Here the schools were asked to submit a school wise report and the same is included.



#### **IMPLEMENTATION CHALLENGES**

- 1. There was Durga Puja Festival in West Bengal in September and October, 2019 which forced the programme to seek for extension of time.
- 2. Due to time constraint, we could not develop training materials and worksheets in other languages than Bengali and English.
- 3. The programme remains pilot basis and all the schools of the districts could not be taken up.
- 4. Other than taking up the whole, identifying 50 students and restricting the numbers of parents to 50 posed challenges for the institutions.
- 5. The schools were interspersed throughout the district which posed challenges for proper supervision.
- 6. The time as decided for school programme fall in the time when Pre-Board examinations were due thus bringing students was also a challenge.
- 7. The Institutions were apprehensive about the participation of the Guardians and lot of deliberations were there whether the Guardians to be involved or not.

This year the programme also exploited a monitoring schedule to know about the issues of implementation and execution.



The results revealed that the tendency of all kinds of substance use is quite common among the guardians during their teenage years, albeit lesser in the female members. The percentage of taking Paan, however, is comparable in both genders. Therefore, there might be some who may have addictions and some long substance users and thus it is imperative that NAPDDR

type of advocacy programme must involve the guardians from hence and probe the related issues further.

All guardians have unequivocally restricted their children from taking any type of substance despite having tried such substances during their own teenage years. Therefore, it is common that children aspiration must be refrained from using any type of Therefore, substances. 



































### **NOTICEABLE OBSERVATIONS OF THE PROGRAMME**

- **1.** The activities were organized as per programmatic norms under the able leadership of the School Team.
- 2. In a novel way to effect a greater outreach, the School Team of Siliguri Hindi High School for Girls (H.S.) translated , prepared and distributed the activity sheets and flash cards in Hindi from English version of the material on their own
- **3.** The School Managing Committee of schools supported the School Team in this endeavour for successful implementation of the programme at the school level. In Kavi Sukanta High School of Pradhannagar, Siliguri, Smt. Kakali Datta, the President of the SMC was at the school and appreciably coordinated all the activities throughout the day.
- **4.** In spite of the demographical and economical nature of the locality, the students and guardians enthusiastically participated in the School Level programmes.
- **5.** The guardians participated beyond the projected estimation by the school authorities and proactively took part in all the activities. In Siliguri Netaji High School, in municipal area of Siliguri, one concerned mother with a 3 month old baby actively took part in the programme from the morning till the end on 13.11.2019.
- 6. In some of the schools of Alipurduar, male guardians also took part in the programme till the closure at late afternoon and some of them opened up about their own habits and discussed its consequences with apprehensions.
- 7. The participation of the guardians was ensured by innovative ways like issuing pamphlets like what the HOI of Baraibari Naranath High School (H.S), Cooch Behar.
- Concern crossed the barrier of language and it was expressed in Urdu and Nepali as in Darjeeling and Kalimpong.

- **9.** The guardian activity sheet was designed with prevalence of pictorial inputs which ensured understanding of the participants.
- **10.** In Tapshikhata High School of Alipurduar, the guardians informed and protested against existence of FL. Off Shop near the school which they expressed is detrimental to their and their wards life and wanted immediate closure.
- **11.** There are many other local variants of substance use which varies from locality to locality, e.g., in these areas people take indigenously processed seeds from the fruit of tea plant and powder derived from burnt tail of common house gecko which is not in the mainstream knowledge. This indigenous substance use may be taken up as separate study which is beyond the ambit of this programme.
- **12.** This programme recognized the guardians and their finer qualities beyond the statutory guidelines of involvement and the guardians were deeply motivated to participate in all school activities from hence which are common observation in all the six districts.

# **PROJECT RISKS & NEXT STEPS**

- 1. In 2018-19, this State proposed for piloting the project in 20 schools of Bankura and Purulia. This year the project is approved for 50 schools of North Bengal. Thus the project remains in the same pilot mode. Therefore the impact of the programme is restricted to a minimum part and the wider outreach is yet to be achieved.
- 2. In this background, the following have been deliberated
  - The project should be again taken back to Bankura and Purulia.
  - All the schools of these two districts other than the 20 to be brought under the programme.
  - There may be a specific "NAPDDR DAY" at the districts and on that day all the schools of the district will organise the awareness programme to learn to say to "No to Drugs".
  - After completion of these two, we will organise the programme in similar fashion in the North Bengal districts where this year we organised the programme.
  - The resource persons and teachers who were part of the programme in the last year will be used as Resource for the districts.



# পড়য়াদের নেশা রুখতে প্রশিক্ষণ শিক্ষকদের

রাজ্যে গুটখা বিক্রিতে নিষেধাজ্ঞা জারি হয়েছে। তা নিয়ে আলোচনার মধ্যেই মাদক, নেশা দ্রব্যের কুফল নিয়ে পভূয়াদের সচেতনতা বাড়াতে উত্তরবঙ্গের ছয় শিক্ষা জেলায় কর্মসূচি নিল রাজ্য শিক্ষা গবেষণা ও প্রশিক্ষণ পরিষদ।

ওই ব্যাপারে সংশ্লিষ্ট জেলার বাছাই করা স্কুলের প্রধান শিক্ষক-সহ পাঁচজন শিক্ষককে নিয়ে কর্মশালা হয়। আলিপুরদুয়ার জেলা শিক্ষা গবেষণা ও প্রশিক্ষণ কেন্দ্রেও ওই বিষয়ে দু'দিনের কর্মশালাটি শনিবার শেষ হয়েছে। উদ্যোক্তারা জানান, কোচবিহার, আলিপুরদুয়ার, জলপাইগুড়ি, শিলিগুড়ি, কালিম্পং ও দার্জিলিংয়ের মোট ৭৫টি স্কুলের প্রধান শিক্ষক ও সহকারী শিক্ষকদের কর্মশালার আওতায় আনা হয়েছে। ১৩ নভেম্বরের ধ্যে কর্মশালায় শামিল শিক্ষকরা জেদের স্কুলের অষ্টম ও নবম াণির পড়ুয়াদের পাশাপাশি, তাদের ভিভাবকদের নিয়ে প্রথম ধাপের শালা করবেন।


ন্যাশনাল অ্যাকশন প্ল্যানিং ড্রাগ ডিমান্ড রিডাকশন (এনএপিডিডিআর) নামে ওই প্রকল্পে জাতীয় নির্দেশিকা মতো রাজ্যের ওই সংস্থা কর্মশালার তদারকি করছে। গত বছর রাজ্যের বাকুঁড়া ও পুরুলিয়া জেলায় 'পাইলট প্রোজেক্ট' হিসেবে ওই উদ্যোগ শুরু হয়েছে বলে জানানো হয়েছে।

উদ্যোক্তাদের সূত্রে জানা গিয়েছে, বিভিন্ন নেশার প্রবণতা স্বাস্থ্যের পক্ষে মারাত্মক ক্ষতির কারণ হতে পারে, সেই বার্তাটাই হাতে কলমে বোঝানোর চেষ্টা হচ্ছে। মূলত, অষ্টম ও নবম শ্রেণির পড়ুয়া ও তাদের অভিভাবকদের প্রাথমিকভাবে কর্মসূচির আওতায় আনা হচ্ছে। কারণ, ওই বয়েসেই, কৌতুহল থেকে নেশার প্রতি ঝোঁক দেখা যায় কিশোরদের মধ্যে। আলিপুরদুয়ার জেলা শিক্ষা গবেষণা ও প্রশিক্ষণ কেন্দ্রের ভারপ্রাপ্ত আধিকারিক অজিত সাহা বলেন, "৫ নভেম্বর থেকে পর্যায়ক্রমে জেলার বিভিন্ন স্কুলের প্রধান শিক্ষক ও সহকারী শিক্ষকরা ওই কর্মশালায় অংশ নিয়েছেন।"

প্রকল্পের সঙ্গে যুক্ত এক প্রশিক্ষক জানিয়েছেন, প্রধান শিক্ষকদের নিজের স্কুলের মাস্টার ট্রেনারের দায়িত্ব সামলানোর জন্য কর্মশালায় আবেদন জানানো হয়েছে। সহকারী শিক্ষকদের ওই ব্যাপারে দলগতভাবে কাজের অনুপ্রেরণা দেওয়া হচ্ছে। নেশার খপ্পরে পড়া কোনও পড়ুয়াকে চিহ্নিত করা কীভাবে সন্তুব, তাকে মূলস্রোতে ফেরানোর জন্য কীভাবে এগোতে হবে, সে সব নানা খুঁটিনাটি বিষয়ও কর্মশালায় বিশদে তুলে ধরা হচ্ছে। পড়ুয়াদের সচেতন করে তুলতে ছবি আঁকা, স্লোগান লেখা, পোস্টার তৈরি, পথনাটিকা, কবিতা, ছোট গল্প লেখার মতো নানা সূজনশীল কাজে তাদের উৎসাহ দেওয়ার পরিকল্পনা রয়েছে।

শুধু অষ্টম ও নবম শ্রেণির পভুয়াদের নিয়ে ওই উদ্যোগ কেন? উদ্যোক্তাদের দাবি, বয়ঃসন্ধির শুরুতেই নানা কারণে নেশার কবলে পড়া, তার প্রতি আসক্তির সম্ভাবনা বেশি থাকে। তাই স্কুলের অষ্টম ও নবম শ্রেণির পভুয়াদের নিয়েই এই ভাবনা।

শালকুমারহাট, ৮ নভেম্বর : স্কুল পড়ুয়াদের নেশামুক্ত করতে রাজা শিক্ষা গবেষণা ও প্রশিক্ষণ পর্ষদ (এসসিইআরটি) একগুচ্ছ পরিকল্পনা নিয়েছে। সংশ্লিষ্ট পর্ষদ সম্প্রতি উত্তরবঙ্গকে কেন্দ্র করে কয়েকটি ধাপে এই কর্মসূচি শুরু করেছে। এজন্য উত্তরবঙ্গের ৭৫টি স্কুলকে বেছে নেওয়া হয়েছে। পড়ুয়াদের পাশাপাশি এই কর্মসূচিতে অভিভাবকরাও শামিল হবেন। এখন বাছাই করা স্কুলের প্রধান শিক্ষক ও সহকারী শিক্ষকদের এসসিইআরটি-র আলিপুরদুয়ার জেলা শিক্ষা ও প্রশিক্ষণ সংস্থায় প্রশিক্ষণ চলছে। ওই সংস্থার অফিসার ইনচার্জ ও উত্তরবঙ্গবাণী এই কর্মসূচিরি দায়িত্বপ্রাপ্ত অধ্যাপক অজিত সাহা বলেন, 'নেশার কবল থেকে পড়ুয়াদের বাঁচাতে এবং কেন, কীভাবে নেশা বর্জন করতে হবে সে সম্পর্কে সচেতন করতেই এবছর উত্তরবঙ্গ পরীক্ষামূলকভাবে এই কর্মসূচি শুরু হয়েছে। শিক্ষকদের প্রশিক্ষণের পরেই বাছাই স্কুলগুলিতে পড়ুয়া ও অভিভাবকদের বিভিন্ন অনুষ্ঠানের মাধ্যমে এই কর্মসূচিতে শামিল করা হবে।'

সরকারি নিষেধাজ্ঞা সন্ধেও উত্তরবঙ্গের বিভিন্ন শিক্ষাপ্রতিষ্ঠানের আশপাশে পান-মশলার দোকান এখনও রমরমিয়ে চলছে। ফলে পড়ুয়াদের একাংশ স্কুলে এসে গুটখা, সিগারেট, তামাক জাতীয় নেশায় আসন্ড হয়ে পড়ছে। নেশার কবল থেকে পড়ুয়াদের রক্ষা করতেই এসসিইআরটি উত্তরবঙ্গজুড়ে পরীক্ষামূলকভাবে নানা কর্মসূচি নিয়েছে। এজন্য উত্তরবঙ্গের ৬টি জেলাকে বেছে নেওয়া হয়েছে। জেলাগুলি হল দার্জিলিং, শিলিগুড়ি, কালিম্পাং, জলপাইগুড়ি, কোচবিহার ও আলিপুরদুয়ার। এইসব জেলা থেকে ৭৫টি হাইস্কুলকে বেছে নেওয়া হয়েছে। এই স্কুলগুলির ৩ হাজার ৭৫০ জন পড়ুয়া এবং ৩ হাজার ৭৫০ জন অভিভাবককে পরীক্ষামূলকভাবে এই কর্মসূচিতে নেওয়া হবে। পাশাপাশি ৭৫টি স্কুলের ৭৫ জন প্রধান শিক্ষক এবং প্রতিটি স্কুলের ৫ জন করে ৩৭৫ জন সহকারী শিক্ষককে দুটি ধাপে প্রশিক্ষণ দেওয়ার কাজ চলছে। গত ৫ ও ৬ নভেম্বর দার্জিলিং,কালিম্পং ও কোচবিহার জেলার শিক্ষকদের প্রশিক্ষণ হয়েছে। গুরুবার থেকে শুরু হয়েছে বাকি তিন জেলার শিক্ষকদের প্রশিক্ষণ। পড়ুয়াদের নেশামুক্ত করার নানা কৌশল উল্লেখ করে উত্তরবঙ্গের বাছাই করা কিছু স্কুলের ১০ জন শিক্ষক প্রশিক্ষণ দিজ্বেন। গোটা কর্মসূচির প্রোগ্রম কোঅর্ডিনেটর নীলাঞ্জন বালা জনিয়েছেন, ১১

নেটা ক্ষুবুটের ভৌত্রাৰ কোনাওদের নাগাজুল বালা জানবেংবে, 5 ১ নভেম্বর দার্জিলিং, কালিম্পাং ও কোচবিহার এবং ১৩ নভেম্বর আলিপুরন্থার, জলপাইগুড়ি ও শিলিগুড়ির বাছাই করা স্কুলগুলির পড়ুয়া ও অভিভাবকদের এই কর্মসূচিতে শামিল করা হবে। তিনি বলেন, 'নেশা নেব না এবং কেন, কীভাবে, নেশা করব না– মূলত এই বিষয়ের উপর পড়ুয়া ও অভিভাবকদের মধ্যে পৃথকভাবে প্রতিযোগিতামূলক বিভিন্ন কর্মসূচির আয়োজন করা হবে। নাটক,অঙ্জন,কবিতা কিংবা নিজস্ব সুজনশীল কোনো কাজের মাধ্যমে পড়ুয়াদের পাশাপাশি অভিভাবকদের মধ্যে থেকে প্রথম স্থান দখলকারীকে পুরস্কৃত করা হবে। সেইসঙ্গে এসসিইআরটি–র তরফে বাছাই করা প্রতিটি স্কুলেই যাবতীয় সরঞ্জাম দেওয়া হবে।
