No. 916-SE(Pry)ES/0/SCERT/4P-35/86 Pt-1.—2nd August 2002.—In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules regulating the recruitment to the posts of Research Fellow Grade II, Research Fellow Grade I and Senior Research Fellow in the State Council of Educational Research and Training, West Bengal, under the School Education Department, Government of West Bengal,

The method of, and the qualifications required for, recruitment to the posts of Research Fellow Grade II, Research Fellow Grade Land Senior Research Fellow in the State Council of Educational Research and Training, West Bengal, under the School Education Department, Government of West Bengal, shall be as detailed below :-

- A. Method of recruitment: By selection (direct recruitment) through the Public Service Commission, West Bengal. ... Name of the post: Research Fellow, Grade II.
- B. Qualifications for direct recruitment: Essential: (i) A consistently good academic record with minimum of 55% marks in the Master Degree and Second class Honours degree in the relevant subject or the equivalent.

Explanations: "A consistently good academic record" means an overall record of all assessment throughout the academic career, that is to say, securing on an average, at least 55% marks in all examinations taken together, namely, Madhyumik or equivalent, Higher Secondary or equivalent, Honours, B.T./B.Ed., P.G.B.T. or equivalent and Master degree stage.

- (ii) B.T./B.Ed./P.G.B.T. or equivalent qualifications.
- (iii) Good power of expression in Bengali or Nepali Language—spoken and written.

Explanation: The State Government may indicate in the requisition form for advertisement the language required for the purpose.

Desirable: A degree in Psychology/Philosophy from a recognised University.

Age: Not more than 35 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement relaxable for persons holding substantive appointment under the Government of West Bengal or Government of India. The age limit is also relaxable in the case of



exceptionally well qualified and experienced candidates.

Note: In respect of specific posts requiring special qualifications, the State Government may, after consultation with the Public Service Commission, West Bengal prescribe the specific qualifications for them,

2 Name of the Post: Research Fellow: Grade I.

- A. Method of recruitment: By promotion in consultation with the Public Service Commission, West Bengal from amongst the Research Fellow, Grade II having six years Service as such. If at any point of time no suitable officer is available for promotion, the post may be filled up by selection (direct recruitment) through Public Service Commission, West Bengal.
- B. Qualifications for direct recruitment: (i) A consistently good academic record with minimum of 55% marks in the Master Degree and Second Class Honours degree in the relevant subject or the equivalent.

Explanation: "A consistently good academic record" means record of all assessment throughout the academic career, that is to say, securing on an average, at least 55% marks in all examinations taken together, namely, Madhyamik or equivalent. Higher Secondary or equivalent Honours, B.T./B.Ed./P.G.B.T. or equivalent and Master Degree stage.

- (ii) B.T./B.Ed./P.G.B.T. or equivalent qualifications.
- (iii) Seven years research experience in a reputed organisation or University.
- (iv) An M.Phil, or a doctorat degree from a recognised University.
- (v) Good power of expression in Bengali or Nepali language-Spoken and Written.

Explanation: The Government may indicate in the requisition form for advertisement the language required for the purpose.

C. Age: Not more than 40 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement relaxable for persons holding substantive appointment under the Government of West Bengal or Government of India. The age limit is also relaxable in the case of exceptionally well qualified and experienced candidates.

Note: In respect of specific posts requiring special qualifications, the State Government may, after consultation with the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, prescribe the specific qualifications for them.

3. Name of the post: Senior Research Fellow.

A. Methord of recruitment: By selection (direct recruitment) through the Public Service Commission, West Bengal

By promotion in consultation with the Public Service Commission, West Bengal from amongst the post of Research Fellow. Grade I having five years service as such.

B. Qualifications for direct recruitment: Essential: (i) A consistently good academic record with First Class Master degree and second class Honours degree or a High Second Class Master degree (at least 55% marks) with a First Class Honours degree in the relevant subject of Arts and Science. (ii) B.T./B.Ed./P.G.B.T. or equivalent qualifications. (iii) A Doctorate degree in the concerned subject from a recognised University. (iv) 10 years experience in research or 5 years experience in Research and 5 years experience in teaching in B.Ed. Colleges or at the Honours/Post Graduate class in a recognised Institution, relaxable at the discretion of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, in the case of candidates of outstanding merit. (v) Good power of expression in Bengali or in Nepali—Spoken and Written.

Desirable: '(i) Experience in guiding research.

(ii) Original publication of high standard.

Explanation: "A consistently good academic record" means an overall good record of assessment throughout the academic career that is to say, securing on an average at least 55% marks in all examinations taken together, namely, Madhyanuk or equivalent, Higher Secondary or equivalent, Honours and Master Degree stage.

Note: In respect of posts requiring special qualifications, the State Government may, in consultation with the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, prescribe such qualifications.

C. Age: Not more than 45 years on the 1st January, of the year of advertisement relaxable for persons holding substantive appointment under the Government of West Bengal/Government of India. The age is also relaxable in the case of exceptionally well-qualified and experienced candidates.
