NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased hereby to make the following rules regulating the recruitment to the posts of Principal, Lecturer, Music Teacher, and Art and Craft Teacher of Primary Teachers' Training Institutes under the Directorate of School Education under the School Education Department, Govt. of West Bengal.

RULES

The method of and the qualifications required for recruitment to the posts of Principal, Lecturer, Music Teacher and Art and Craft Teacher of Primary Teachers' Training Institutes under the School Education Directorate under the School Education Department, Govt. of West Bengal, shall be as detailed below :-

- A. Principal :  
Method of recruitment : By selection from amongst confirmed Lecturers of Primary Teachers' Training Institutes under the School Education Directorate under the Government of West Bengal, having at least 5 years' experience as such and having a Master Degree with post Graduate degree or Diploma in teacher education from a recognised university.
- B. Lecturer :  
a) Method of recruitment : By selection (direct recruitment).  
b) Qualifications : (i) Essential :  
(i) A second class Master Degree of 2 years' course with Honours at graduation level in Bengali/Nepali/Urdu, History, English, Geography, Mathematics, Science (Botany/Zoology/Physics/Chemistry) of Education from a recognised University.  
(ii) Post graduate Diploma in Basic Education (PDBE) recognised by the Government of West Bengal or a B.Ed. Degree, not in physical Education or work Education, of a recognised University.  
(iii) Ability to teach in Bengali in Primary Teachers' Training Institutes in which instruction is provided in Bengali.  
(ii) Desirable :  
(i) Knowledge of Bengali-spoken and written, Knowledge of Urdu or Nepali spoken and written-desirable in Primary Teachers' Training Institutes in which instruction is provided in Urdu or Nepali, as the case may be.  
(ii) Knowledge of latest developments on elementary Education/Teacher Education of the State and that of India.  
(iii) Special proficiency in sports, art, craft, music, social, Service, campus activities or gardening.  
c) Age :  
Below 35 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement, relaxable upto 40 years for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe or other reserved categories as per the existing rules, and for persons holding substantive appointment in teaching branch of the School Education Directorate, Govt. of West Bengal.
- C. Music Teacher :  
a) Method of recruitment : By selection (direct recruitment).  
b) Qualifications : (i) Essential :  
(i) A pass in Higher Secondary conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education, or its equivalent.  
(ii) B. Mus. Degree in Music from any recognised University.  
(iii) Ability to teach in Bengali.

(ii) Desirable : Knowledge of Bengali-spoken and written  
(c) Age : Below 35 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement, relaxable upto 40 years for candidates belonging to scheduled caste or scheduled Tribe and for persons holding substantive appointment in teaching branch of the school Education Directorate, Govt. of West Bengal.

**D. Art and Craft Teacher :**

- (a) Method of recruitment : By selection (direct recruitment).
- (b) Qualification : Essential :
  - (i) A pass in Madhyamik conducted by the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education or its equivalent.
  - (ii) Degree in Bachelor of Visual Art and Crafts/5-years Diploma in Art and Craft from any Govt. Art College/recognized University.
  - (iii) Ability to teach in Bengali.
  - (iv) Desirable : Knowledge of Bengali-spoken and written.
- (c) Age : Below 35 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement. Age is relaxable upto 40 years for candidates belonging to Scheduled caste or Scheduled Tribe and for persons holding substantive appointment in teaching branch under the School Education Directorate, Govt. of West Bengal.

**E. OTHER CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL THE POSTS :**

- (a) The appointing authority shall be the Director of School Education, West Bengal.
- (b) Scale of pay shall be as admissible for the relevant post in terms of the relevant pay and allowance Rules of the State Government and dearness allowance and other allowances shall be as admissible.
- (c) Both men and women candidates shall be eligible to apply and to be considered.
- (d) Service shall be transferable within the State or West Bengal.
- (e) Stay in the Institute's campus shall be obligatory.
- (f) Selection shall be made by a committee consisting of the following members :-

- 1. A nominee of the Director of School Education, West Bengal, not below the rank of Joint Director of School Education. ... Chairman
- 2. Deputy Director of School Education (Rural Primary) ... Member.
- 3. Deputy Director of School Education (Administration). ... Member.
- 4. Principal, David Hare Training College, 25/1, Bellygunge Circular Rd., Calcutta-19, or his nominee, not below the rank of Readers ... Member.
- 5. Principal, Institute of Education for Women or his nominee, Hastings House, 26-3, Judges Court, Calcutta - 27. ... Member.
- 6. Nominee of the School Education Department, not below the rank of Assistant Secretary ... Member.
- 7. Deputy Director of School Education (Basic). ... Member-convenor
