In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all previous notifications on the subject, the Governor is pleased hereby to make, with immediate effect, the following rules regulating the recruitment to the post of Director of State Council of Educational Research and Training, West Bengal :-

Rules

The method of and the qualifications required for recruitment to the post of Director, State Council of Educational Research and Training, shall be as detailed below :-

A. Method of recruitment :

By selection (direct recruitment) through the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, departmental candidates being eligible to apply.

B. Qualifications :

Essential —

- A consistently good academic record with a 1st Class Master Degree and a 2nd Class Honours Degree or a High 2nd Class Master Degree (at least 55%) with a 1st Class Honours Degree in any subject.
- A Doctorate Degree from a recognised University.
- Ten years' experience in teaching in recognised degree or post graduate college and/or University.
- Five years' experience in administration in an academic body of any institution in a comparable rank.
- Good power of expression in Bengali and English - Spoken and Written.

Desirable :

- i) Experience in guiding research.
- ii) Original publications of high standard.

Explantation :

A consistently good academic record shall mean an overall record of all assessments throughout the academic career, that is to say, securing on an average at least 55% marks in all examinations taken together,

namely, Madhyamik or equivalent, Higher Secondary or equivalent, Honours and Master Degree stages.

C. Age :

Not more than 45 years on the first day of January of the year of advertisement, relaxable for highly qualified and experienced candidates and for persons holding substantive appointment in the teaching branch of the Education Department of the Government of West Bengal.
