Education Department may kindly refer to their above memo. SCERT has been formed in West Bengal through the merger of a number of Training Colleges and units. At present, salaries and other expenditures in respect of these constituent units of the SCERT are being met from the following provisions in the Non-Plan Budget which have been placed at the disposal of the Director, SCERT, West Bengal for the year 1984-85 by G.O. No.184(6)-Edn(B) dt.28th May, 1984;

277A-Primary-IX-Other Expenditure-Non-Plan

1. State Institute of Education for improvement of Elementary Education Rs.4,54,000/-

277B-Secondary

VI- Teachers' Training - Fifth Plan (Committed)

1. UNICEF Programme for Science Education in Schools (classes VI-VIII) Rs.2,00,000/-

277E-University and other Higher Education-III

Govt. Colleges-Non-Plan

1. Training Colleges for Teachers Rs.5,00,000
Rs.11,54,000/-

It has been rightly suggested in the above Memo. of the Education Department that these provisions should be "withdrawn and brought together under a single Non-Plan head for the SCERT, West Bengal." As the DPI controls the non-Plan Budget for the entire Education Directorate, it has also been aptly stated that "and DPI should be involved in the process".

As the SCERT has been described in G.O. No.556-Edn(P) dt.28.7.83 as a Post-Graduate Research-cum-Training Institute, it had been suggested in our original proposal (No.63/SCERT dt.24.8.83) that the new Head for the SCERT in the Non-Plan Budget should be placed immediately after item no.4 in Budget Head 277E(III) Training Colleges for Teachers and numbered as 5 and the existing item no.5 be re-numbered as 6. It will be much appreciated if the Edn. Department kindly accepts this suggestion and orders the opening of the new Non-Plan Budget Head for SCERT in consultation with the office of the DPI, West Bengal.
